WORK SCHOOL CHILDREN'S PROGRAM

- <u>IF</u> YOU SAY THE ABOVE WORDS, YOU WILL HAVE A LONG TALK with THE CUSTOMS AGENT TO TRY TO <u>UNSAY</u> THEM. We are <u>not</u> legally working because we are not receiving any payment for our services. The word "children" brings up the idea of "nanny" which is a common way that immigrants work illegally. We are not nannies!
- Two individuals have had problems entering CA for this very mistake. It is a huge headache and hours of work to clear up, and may cause suspicion to fall on our host church. So avoid troubles, tell the truth, and sail through as the tourist that you truly are. Pastor Westerveld has personally interviewed with Canadian immigration authorities about our activities and they are perfectly legal. However, the decision lays on the <u>individual border guard</u> that is examining you at the moment. So DON'T say the things above or you may open up many problems for your group.
- We will have a letter of invitation from our hosts that seems to reassure the border officials, one for each car.
- 3. **Return Crossing in USA**: Your documents proving US citizenship will be scrutinized. It is important to have documents out to cross back into the U.S. During the VBS week, Olivia can hold all documents for minors in a safe place so they will not be lost. On the return trip each car will receive their own documents back; please do not switch cars until after the border crossing
