Last minute checklist Team 2024 ENGLISH FOR KIDS

Everyone needs:

- Use the packing list on the team website; minimize packing to an airplane overhead bin sized luggage, water bottle with your name on it, pillow, plus a purse or bag that you keep with you in the car.
- Bedding according to the list on the team page; most people need none.
- Send your financial contribution unless your church does that to you [see money details on the website]
- Save any receipts as directed on the Money details link. You can bring them to give to Olivia or photo and email them.
- Any special items you are named to bring on the TEAM WEBSITE List of Stuff page for your assigned job.

<u>Check the list at the last minute!</u> I update it often! I will post "Final" at the top when it is done.

DOCUMENTS TO BRING WITH YOU

- Medical Release and Insurance form -give to your group leader before departure
- Give one of the Phone Contact lists to your parents or family before leaving. If you are bringing a phone, put the Quebec leader contacts into your phone contacts.
- Check the schedule for travel/loading from your region.
- Your medical insurance card or proof of travel insurance.
- US drivers need to have the letter of introduction from St. Georges church and all relevant Border Id in one envelope in your car before leaving.
- If you have a cell phone, do a power cycle after you cross into CA air coverage or you may not get calls and texts correctly. The settings on your phone also govern whether you get text/calls when roaming so you should check those.

■ Correct Border ID

Age 15 or lower: <u>Birth certificate</u> + <u>Legal photo ID</u> + <u>notarized permission</u> to travel (give to the driver of the car you will be in at border crossing)

Age 16-18 <u>Passport</u> or <u>Enhanced ID</u>+ <u>notarized permission</u> to travel - (give to the driver of the car you will be in at border crossing)

Age 18 and up: Passport - have this available at the border crossing
