SERMON REFLECTIONS

The Comfort of God's Omniscience:

Because God knows all things, we need never fear that someday something evil in us will spring up and startle God, turning His affection from us. He will never say: "Oh, look at that horrible sin! I didn't know that was there. How terrible! That changes everything. I won't have anything to do with that person anymore." If God in Christ were not omniscient, that might well happen. But God knows all things. He knows the worst about us and loves us anyway.

The Warning of God's Omniscience:

Never say, "I can do it, Lord. I know I can. I know my heart." Say rather, "Lord you know what is there. You put it there. You know what love I have for you. Take it and make it into something that will abound to your glory." Amen!
