Introduction: Herod & John The Baptist Matthew 14:1-13

The wickedness of Herod Antipas' family drives the grudge which leads to Queen Herodias' request for John the Baptist's head. This couple was full of murderous fury at John because he condemned their ungodly marriage. It was ungodly because Herodias was originally married to Herod Philip, the father of Salome and brother of Antipas (Salome dances in Matthew 14:6.) It is this adulterous relationship which is roundly condemned by John the Baptist. The result is a grudge which Herodias nurses until she sees her opportunity to demand from her drunk husband the head of the Baptist in Matthew 14:8-11.

Reflection: Oh, what a longed-for day the Day of Judgment will be, when the cry for justice from the martyred will be answered by the perfect justice of God! In terms of Revelation 6:9-11, John the Baptist is even now one of the voices which cries out for justice for his innocent bloodshed at the hands of Herod Antipas! "Stay at peace, dear John: the day is coming. Even so, come Lord Jesus!"

Christ's Response: No wonder Christ withdraws with His disciples (Mt 14:13) to protect them from this threat and to keep them from panicking. Beyond that, Christ draws apart to offer prayers *that will result in* the preserving of their faith (Lk 22:32); their deliverance from the storm on the lake and because His obedient prayers and cries are offered on our behalf in every trial and crisis (Hebrews 5:7-9).
