INSURANCE COVERAGE INFORMATION - IMPORTANT NOTICE

Health insurance in Canada revised 2026

Over my 15+ years of taking this trip, I have had to take 3 staff members to a hospital in Quebec. We are thankful that in Quebec there is good, modern medical assistance available, and their emergency services are excellent. There is a very good hospital right in St. Georges.

Health Coverage: For illnesses that are serious but not emergencies, we could take a staff person to the clinic in Jackman, Maine for consultation, which is about an hour away. Of course, parents would be consulted for nonemergency issues.

In emergency medical situations, we are thankful that medical care is close by. Your family's health insurance may cover in Canada. You should know that NH or VT (i.e. Green Mountain Health) Medicaid plans do not cover in Canada. Even for those who have policies that claim coverage abroad, the process of settling claims with other health plans is very difficult and requires official translations from French to English and back.

Each family should assess their own health insurance policies and risk. The English for Kids program cannot cover any emergency medical service costs.

Here is a link for some inexpensive policies, below. You can use any company. I myself purchase a plan every year. It is a very cheap policy that is peace of mind. If the cost of travel insurance is a hardship to your family, the program can reimburse the cost of travel health insurance if you submit the receipt to Olivia afterwards.
