INTRO: God governs the world in infinite wisdom, and creatures, and all their actions, are continually under his eye. The eye of Providence is quick-sighted—it *runs*; it is intent - it runs *to and fro*; it reaches far – *through the whole earth*, no corner of which is out of its reach, though the most dark or distant; and His eye directs His hand, and the arm of His power; for He shows Himself strong. Does Satan walk to and fro in the earth? Providence *runs* to and fro, is never absent, never hides and must be sought, and is never at a loss. (Matthew Henry)
