1. You shall have no other gods before me.

7. You shall not commit adultery.

Among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality....Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord....Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her.... Eph 5:3, 22-25

8. You shall not steal.

He who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with his own hands, that he may have something to share with those in need. Eph 4:28

9. You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to his neighbor, for we are all members of one body. Eph 4:28

10. You shall not covet...anything that belongs to your neighbor.
