Intro: Christ Brings Hope Through The Necessity of The Cross - not through a “nightmare denial” of the Cross’ unpleasantness, which wrongly separates Cross from Resurrection

For the Cross, in actuality gives hope:

1. By Confirming The Wisdom of the Word of God
2. Making Hearts Burn Through The Instrumentality of The Word
3. By Hearing The Voice of The Shepherd As He Opens His Mouth in Prayer
