

Checklist for Packing

- Cell phones - allowed but check with your long-distance plan! --
- Electrical outlets are the same as the US.
- Cell phones are for communication and for taking pictures, but in general we will leave our cell phones in our rooms during the day. Only Adult leaders need to have a cell phone to communicate or call 911. We may set one "phone day" for taking pictures. Even in your off time, of course check in with your parents, but try to stay present with our team and not on social media sites. Its more kind to your teammates and your friends at home. The team will send a prayer update and pictures daily to any of your contacts.
- Email to Olivia all e-dresses of people to get our team daily prayer update while you are gone!
- If you plan to use a charge/debit card to pay for things, call in your travel notification!
- ** Border identification - bring it! (see Border ID page for details on Team Page)
- *** bring your normal health insurance card that you carry with you when you go to the doctor OR your travel insurance information
- Air mattresses -- see housing chart on the team website - **only if required** for you
- Sleeping bag, pillow -- IF YOU NEED IT -- SEE housing chart
- You DO NOT need to bring a personal fan. The church is supplying these.
- Flashlight and a watch (so you don't need your phone)
- **Water bottle with your name on it.**
- Bug repellent/sun screen/glasses or contacts?
- Rain gear
- Washcloth and toiletries - make a shower bag to carry to the bathroom.
- Any medicines that you may need
- Bible and a notebook/pen
- Money: Bring your own personal spending money if you'd like to buy souvenirs. (see money details on the team page)
- For Sunday: nicer but casual clothes for Sunday worship are o.k. No need to dress up.
- Casual clothes for 7 days—modest active wear! We will wear staff shirts each day during the camp, but you might want a few for the evenings. Also, modest sleepwear. Do not plan for laundry, but it can be done in an emergency.
- Clothing: we are representing the Lord Jesus Christ. Girls, your shorts should be modest and please do not choose to wear leggings without shorts over (ask me if you have questions!) Bathing suits should be modest for both sexes and shirts should not have objectional wording or political statements.
- Shoes - we can't afford time to take even one staff member to get stitches, so please wear sneakers/closed-toed shoes and save flip flops for the pool & shower!
- Do not bring nuts in any snack food. Nut allergies in the camp. You can bring a few personal snacks.
- Swim suit/towel - we will have a clothesline for hanging these out to dry. Bring a **small, thin** towel that dries quickly NOT a big beach towel.
- Warmer clothes for cool nights, jacket or sweatshirt for cool days (Be prepared for chilly weather)
