The Blood-Bought Power of the Word “Amen.”

Heidelberg Catechism Q & A 129. What is the meaning of the word “Amen”? “Amen” means: so shall it truly and surely be. For my prayer is much more certainly heard of God than I feel in my heart that I desire these things of Him. (2 Cor. 1:20; 2 Tim. 2:13; Ps. 145:18–19.)

*“Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever.
Amen.”
—Ephesians 3:20–21*

- I. Amen as expressing confidence that our prayers “are more certainly heard.”
- II. Because Christ’s blood speaks so prevailingly and effectively.
- III. So that all heaven and earth will one day say together, “Amen!” (Revelation 5:6-14)
